Tilt Renewables (the Proponent) provides this response to a Request for Further Information (RFI) received in relation to the Latrobe Valley Battery Energy Storage System (PA2101132) from the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning in a letter dated 28 April 2021.

Point 1

As specified in the RFI, the Proponent is required to provide:

An amended set of development plans and elevations showing the following details and fully labelled, including dimensioned setbacks of all development from title boundaries:

- a. Compass point;
- b. Adjacent roads labelled;

c. Detail of associated infrastructure including access roads, civil works and boundary and/or internal fencing;

There should be a clear relationship between the infrastructure shown in detail views such as those provided, and the corresponding location of such infrastructure on the site plan.

An amended set of development plans has been provided at Appendix B of the Development Application Report.

Point 2

As specified in the RFI, the Proponent is required to provide:

An additional plan showing the Land Subject to Inundation Overlay and Floodway Overlay overlaid on top of the Site Layout Plan

Point 3 b¹

The current or previous use of the land and whether it constitutes strategically important agricultural land.
