Dear Sophie,

We write with regard to your request for further information regarding Clause 52.17 in the City of Stonnington Planning Scheme.

We confirm that all native vegetation on the St Kevin's Glendalough campus proposed for removal has been cultivated, is not naturally occurring on the site and is not of Victorian origin. Native vegetation proposed for removal include the genera Brachychiton, Agonis, Syzygium and Callistemon cv. Specifically, the trees proposed for removal are numbered within the supplied report as 95, 96, 98, 99 and 100. All other vegetation proposed for removal is of exotic origin. We therefore consider that an exemption should be granted as per the table in the above clause.
