

## APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO TAKE PROTECTED FLORA

Apply to the DELWP Regional Office for approval to take protected flora within that region from:

- public land for non-commercial purposes, or
- private land for commercial collection of grasstrees, tree-ferns and sphagnum moss.

Apply to the Environmental Research Co-ordinator for approval to take protected flora from:

- two or more DELWP regions, or
- any public land for commercial collection.


