**DROOP STREET TRAM CORRIDOR UPGRADES  
PLANNING PERMIT APPLICATION FOR TRAM STOP #62: DROOP STREET /  
NICHOLSON STREET, FOOTSCRAY**

As part of the Droop Street Tram Corridor Upgrade project, the Department of Transport and Planning (**DTP**) is delivering five new level-access tram stops along Gordon Street and Droop Street in Footscray. As part of this project, upgrade works to Tram Stop #60 (northbound): Droop Street / Tiernan Street and Tram Stop #62: Droop Street / Nicholson Street will require a planning permit in accordance with the requirements of the Maribyrnong Planning Scheme.

Separate planning permit applications have been prepared for each stop, inclusive of associated tramway works at each location.

I am pleased to submit for a planning permit application for the demolition of street furniture and buildings and works associated with a tramway in accordance with Clause 43.01-1 of the Maribyrnong Planning Scheme.
