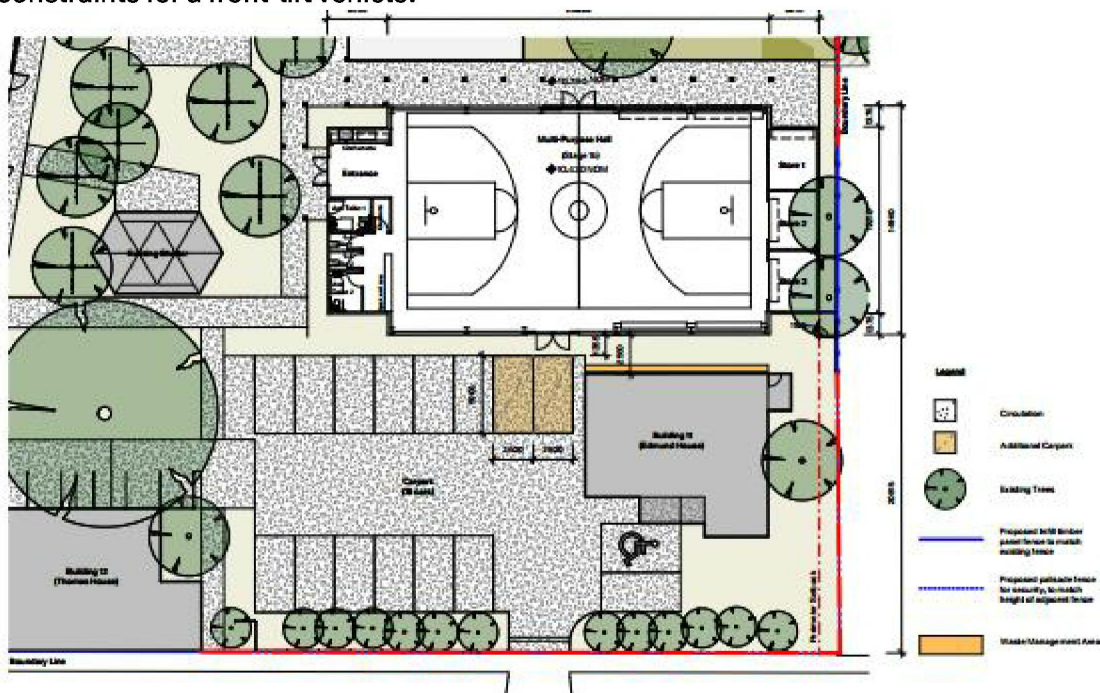

Based on the details provided, Wasteflex can easily service the proposed increase of 16 students. There is sufficient space available to manoeuvre the bins in and out of the location to the truck to complete the service accordingly.

However, the Front Lift General Waste service will need to be amended to a Rear Lift service, as the current site layout and access arrangements are more suitable for rear-lift collection. This will ensure the bins can be safely and efficiently serviced without access or clearance constraints for a front-lift vehicle.



To assist with the increase in capacity requirements, I have recommended the introduction of two (2) x 1100L General Waste bins. While this does represent a reduction of approximately 400L when transitioning away from the front-lift service, this shortfall has been considered as part of a broader service adjustment.

For the remaining waste streams, I have suggested an increase in collection frequency as the first point of alignment to better match on-site waste generation with disposal capacity. Following a six-week period of operating under the newly proposed waste management plan, I would recommend conducting a site audit. This will allow us to assess actual disposal volumes

and servicing efficiency and will assist in further fine-tuning the site's requirements to ensure the most appropriate and cost-effective solution is in place moving forward.

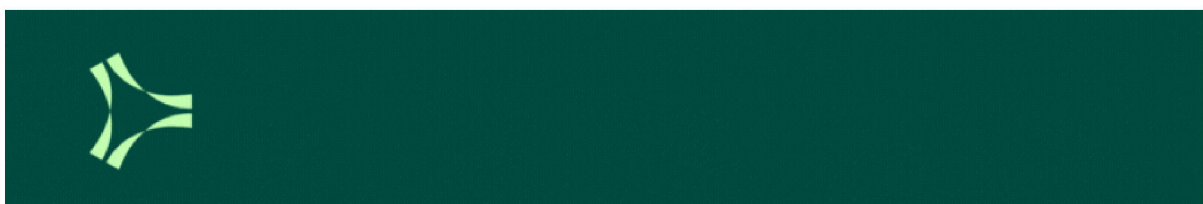
