It was lovely to meet you yesterday and thanks for sending through your presentation.

As discussed in our meeting, the project area contains no sites included in the Heritage Inventory for archaeological potential, nor are there places included in the Victorian Heritage Register for archaeological significance. I also note that the project area has undergone significant ground disturbance. This does not, however, mean there is no potential for the area to yield archaeological remains and as such, the implementation of an Unexpected Finds Protocol (UFP) is strongly recommended. The UFP should be outlined during site induction and explain that archaeological sites (know and previously unknown) are protected under the blanket provisions of the Heritage Act 2017. In the event archaeological remains are encountered during surface disturbing activities, consultation with Heritage Victoria may be necessary to determine an appropriate course of action.

Hi Gretta

As discussed, based on the preliminary information we've received, it appears that the proposed gantry and related works are not within our leases boundary. To the extent that final design is likewise outside of our lease boundary we don't have any particular concerns. However as discussed in our meeting last month, as these works will also fall within the CityLink Planning Overlay, planning permits will need to be submitted to DoT/Transurban for consideration and we may offer comments and seek conditions through that process depending on the final design. Of interest to us will be the construction methodology and protection measures taken to protect our assets in the area. To the extent that access to our leased land is required to carry out the works, we will seek agreement with the developer on management of that access so we have visibility and control over the timing of the works to ensure that the works don't interfere with our ability to carry out our operational activities during the construction phase.

Beyond that we have no further comments in connection with this proposal but look forward to being involved once the project progresses.
