Further to the email correspondences below on this matter, now that the administrative appeal of the planning permits in the Supreme Court has been dismissed we are looking to formalise our application to amend the planning permits for the Delburn Wind Farm.

We are looking for written confirmation from CFA that the attached proposed amendments to the conditions are agreeable either by dated letter (preferred) or email. I note that referral agency confirmation needs to be dated within 3 months of any application (and hence the request for the updated confirmation).

I can confirm that the amendments to the conditions attached are the same to those consented to via email on 29 July 2022, except for:

- The requested change to the Bushfire Risk Familiarisation condition has been made to all 3 wind energy facility permits;
- All three wind energy facility planning permits are provided for fullness (rather than just the Latrobe example);
- Inconsequential changes to text formatting or reference to matters not relevant to those permits (i.e. visitor
 information centre is only in Latrobe and not the other LGAs) have been removed as being implemented by
 corrections to the permits by DTP.


