#### **Preliminary Assessment**

## 0 RESPONSE

The planning report (prepared by proUrban dated 14 June 2024) states that the existing 1200mm drainpipe will be replaced with two x 1200mm drainpipes, which will sit side by side (in the same location). Despite this, the Heritage Advice (prepared by Jem Archaeology dated 16 August 2023) states that the proposed activity involves the replacement of an existing 1200mm diameter concrete pipe with a new 1500mm concrete pipe and box culvert.

Please refer to the updated Cultural Heritage Advice letter prepared by Jem Archaeology, which confirms the works involve the replacement of the existing 1200mm drainpipe with two x 1200mm drainpipes.

Confirmation should be provided as to the extent of the replacement drainage works and, whether or not a CHMP is required. ADVERTISED PLAN

The planning report (prepared by proUrban dated 14 June 2024) states that it is proposed to remove 0.022 hectares of native vegetation including 2 large trees within the land at 33 Princes Highway. Despite this, the report prepared by Arbor Survey – Construction Impact Assessment notes that there are 4 Eucalyptus camaldulensis (River Red Gum) trees to be removed. Documents should be amended to be consistent to ensure accurate assessment of native vegetation removal

Please refer to the updated ecology report, prepared by EHP, that confirms the loss of four trees total (of which two are considered large trees). See Table A1.3 and Figure 2 specifically.

This has also been confirmed within the updated planning report prepared by proUrban.
