Good morning,

Pursuant to Section 48 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, please take this email as notification to the landowner (the Minister for Environment) that Brooke Starbuck (the applicant) seeks to lodge a planning permit application to amend the planning permit 201529926-15 under Section 72 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*.

Land affected by this proposal is identified as Crown Allotment 2032, the Parish of Changue East, Mount Buller (referred to as 'Parcel B') (see attached 'Att 2 – Plan of Crown Allotment').

It is proposed to amend the endorsed plans of planning permit 201529926-15 to add an additional terrace, increase the lower ground floor area to match the existing building footprint, and make minor changes to the floor layout associated with Cabin 8 located in Parcel B (8/12 White Horse Village Road, Mount Buller). Proposed plans included in the planning application are attached for reference.
